Mauao Operational and Maintenance	August 2018 - Recourse Consent application has been lodged for the consent level design of the base track solution as Publically Notified - Detailed design is underway to further develop the solutions for the construction tender - A heritage authority application is being prepared for the base track project works - A major focus this period has been the completion of the planned planting for the 2018 season with support from volunteers and Tangata whenua this year approximately 20,000 plants were planted on the Maunga - Myrtle Rust monitoring is ongoing with no confirmed siting of the rust on Mauao at this stage - Staff have also been working to support the development of the implementation plan for the actions in the Mauao Historic Reserve Management Plan.
