Mauao Operational and Maintenance	December 2011 - Most slip repair work has been completed with the 4x4 and the Base track fully open. Native vegetation has been planted in the largest slips. - The Oruahine track remains closed while consultation and consent processes are completed. Planned work is expected to start early February 2012 and the Oruahine track is expected to be open in March 2012. - Oil from the Rena incident has washed up on the foreshore of Mauao. Maritime have been cleaning up the oil since and are still cleaning. - Department of Conservation has been regularly collecting wild life from around Mauao. All of the recovered wild life has been returned to Mauao.	April 2012 - Rena's oil arrived on Mauao's foreshore. Maritime NZ have had teams collecting wildlife and taken them to a wildlife centre to remove oil. All wildlife taken from Mauao has been returned. - Maritime have cleaned the rocks around Mauao. They used many methods. Mauao's foreshore has been left relatively clean and oil free. - The Oruahine track has been repaired. After gaining consents a second crib wall was installed to repair the area which was damaged by a rock fall. - Average visitor numbers have been recorded for the summer months. October 2012 - A number of small slips have occurred during the winter. Each event has been attended by an iwi monitor and NZ Historic Places Trust. - Maintenance to the Waikorire track has progressed as weather has allowed throughout the winter. - Track counters captured more than 1 million visitors to Mauao between June 2011 and July 2012.	s 7(2)(f)(ii)
