Mauao Management	June 2011 - The most significant issue during this period has been managing the repair and reopening of Mauao following the storm event that closed the mountain on 29th January 2011. Sections of Mauao have been opened when they have been deemed safe. - On the 25th April, heavy rain caused a	December 2011 - Most slip repair work has been completed with the 4x4 and the Base track fully open. Native vegetation has been planted in the largest slips. - The Oruahine track remains closed while consultation and consent processes are completed. The Mauao Trustees and Steering Group member were informed by email of the new slips on the 26th March. - On the 8th May heavy rain caused the slip number 6 (just past the start of the very steep goat track at the harbour entrance on the Base track) to reactivate. - Work is continuing with the slip repairs, including the design and consent process for the most significant of the sites. Security fences and signage are still in place to restrict access to areas still closed. - The prognosis is that these areas will remain closed for a number of months while the agreed repairs are designed, consented and constructed.
