		- Base track, infill of rock on the seaward side of the base track has been completed. - Continuation of the Base Track surface overlay. Three quarters of the track has now been completed. - The breach of a terrace has been filled with a set of box steps going where the breach was. This has joined up the new summit tracks (by the Trig) with the summit bush track. - January's storm event. Mauao has been closed due to severe damage, caused by a storm. Some tracks will be opened asap, with sections remaining closed for many months. Waitangi day's dawn service on the summit has been cancelled.	been opened when they have been deemed safe. - On the 25th April, heavy rain caused a medium size slip just beyond Sandy beach on the Harbour side of the Base track; there was a rock fall on the Oruahine track; the camp ground slip also reactivated and the 4x4 track slip reactivated. The Mauao Trustees and Steering Group member were informed by email of the new slips on the 26th March. - On the 8th May heavy rain caused the slip number 6 (just past the start of the very steep goat track at the harbour entrance on the Base track) to reactivate. - Work is continuing with the slip repairs, including the design and consent process for the most significant of the sites. Security fences and signage are still in place to restrict access to areas still closed. - The prognosis is that these areas will remain closed for a number of months while the agreed repairs are designed, consented and constructed.
