		been deemed safe. - On the 25th April, heavy rain caused a medium size slip just beyond Sandy beach on the Harbour side of the Base track; there was a rock fall on the Oruahine track; the camp ground slip also reactivated and the 4x4 track slip reactivated. The Mauao Trustees and Steering Group member were informed by email of the new slips on the 26th March. - On the 8th May heavy rain caused the slip number 6 (just past the start of the very steep goat track at the harbour entrance on the Base track) to reactivate. - Work is continuing with the slip repairs, including the design and consent process for the most significant of the sites. Security fences and signage are still in place to restrict access to areas still closed. - The prognosis is that these areas will remain closed for a number of months while the agreed repairs are designed, consented and constructed.	- The Oruahine track remains closed while the Project Manager works through a Resource Consent, for the crib wall which is needed. This track will remain closed for at least a month. - Summit upgrade project is now completed with a loop track being installed as proposed in the Conservation Plan 2004. - Spring weed control has been completed targeting gorse and thistles in the paddocks. Contractors a halfway through weed control on the summit bluffs. - Lambing is over with very few issues from the public.
