	Mauao Operational and Maintenance	June 2017 - Cyclones Debbie and Cook caused much erosion and damage to Mauao, which required a substantial clean up this period. - A major slip on the Pilot Bay side of the base track has closed part of the track until a suitable long term solution can be developed. This will take some time and therefore a temporary diversion is planned to provide the loop connection in the short term. - The 2017 planting season is underway as planned. Approximately 10,000 plants will be put in this season with a combination of volunteer and contractor support - Great progress has been made on the rabbit control with an estimated 855 reduction in the population since January 2017 - Ongoing plant and animal pest control, track, sign and structure maintenance	December 2017 - Tender for professional services to remediate damage to the Mauao base track has taken place. Contract to be awarded in December. - A temporary bypass track was created to re-connect the base track loop while a long term solution is developed. - An onsite induction was held for key maintenance contractors and staff that work on the Maunga with the designated archaeologist for the purposes of heritage protection - Two baseline surveys were completed this period to identify, locate ensure the appropriate future management of Threatened Plants and lizard species within the reserve. - Ongoing plant and animal pest control, track, sign and structure maintenance. - Planting plan has been finalised for the May	s 7(2)(f)(ii)
