HP	Mauao Management	October 2011 - The Base Track at Mauao was reopened mid June after the slips earlier in the year. The proposed bridge at slip 5 was not needed as temporary slip repair work went really well. - The Oruahine track remains closed while the Project Manager works through a Resource Consent, for the crib wall which is needed. This track will remain closed for at least a month. - Summit upgrade project is now completed with a loop track being installed as proposed in the Conservation Plan 2004. - Spring weed control has been completed targeting gorse and thistles in the paddocks. Contractors a halfway through weed control on the summit bluffs. - Lambing is over with very few issues from the public.	April 2012 - Rena's oil arrived on Mauao's foreshore. Maritime NZ have had teams collecting wildlife and taken them to a wildlife centre to remove oil. All wildlife taken from Mauao have been returned. - Maritime have cleaned the rocks around Mauao. They used many methods. Mauao's foreshore has been left relatively clean and oil free. - The Oruahine track has been repaired. After gaining consents a second crib wall was installed to repair the area which was damaged by a rock fall. - Average visitor numbers have been recorded for the summer months.	§ 7(2)(f)(ii)
