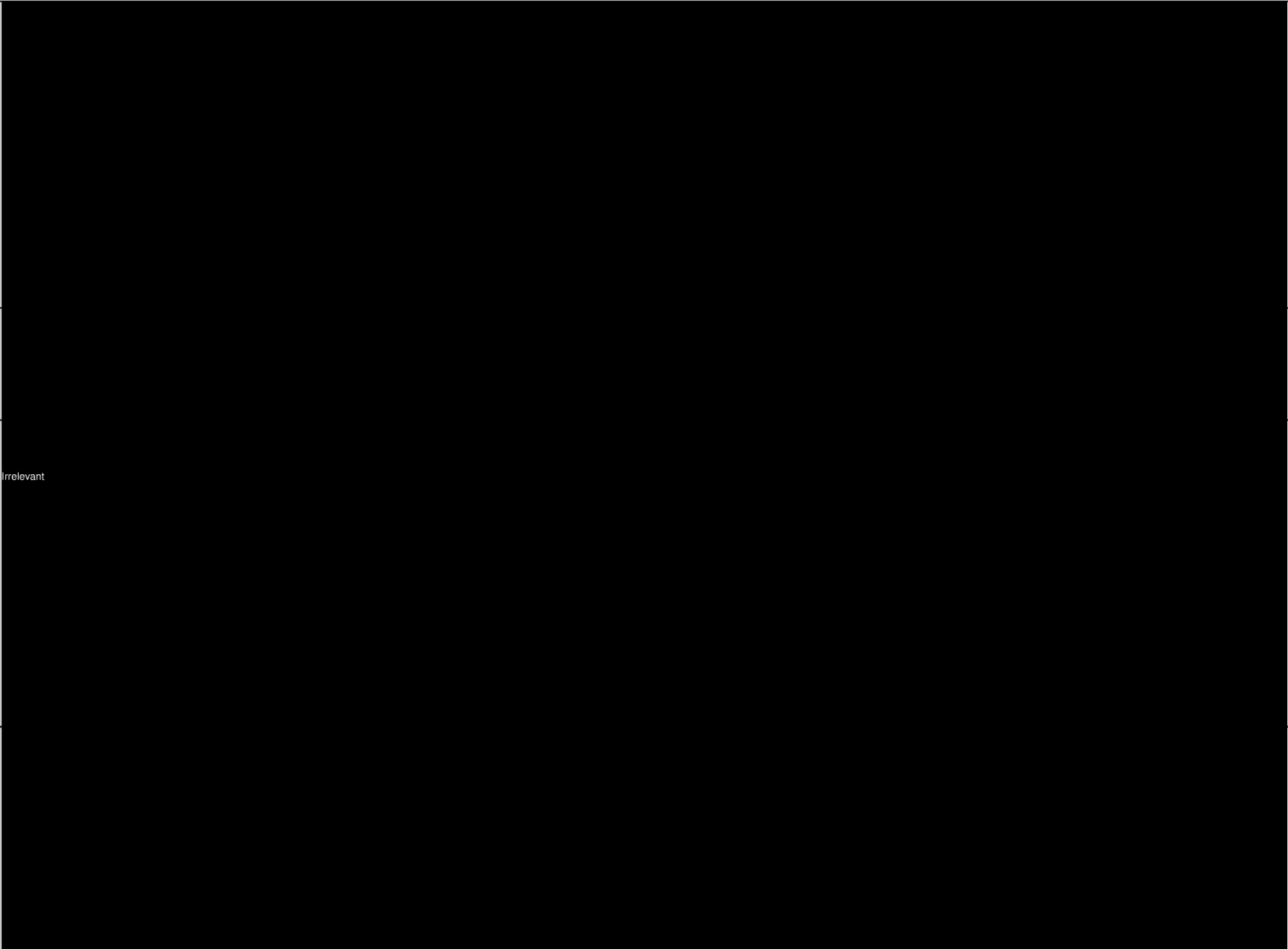

HP	Mauao Management	- Numbers of visitors to the park have continued to grow over the summer period with counts exceeding 100,000 people per month. - The replacement of the last remaining stile on the base track has been well received. - An engineering report has been completed to assess the stability of the Mauao Base Track. Repair priorities have been identified and staff are currently assessing that report and will present it to the Mauao Steering Group at the next meeting on Wednesday 18th April 2007. - A renewal of the existing 3 information panels has been discussed with more input from HPT than was previously included. One sign was destroyed by the slip on Pilot Quay (May 18, 2005). Current thinking is to not have many small information panels scattered around Mauao, but larger informative signs at the entrance. With an Information Kiosk potentially attached to the Hot Pool extensions, there is a lot of scope to educate the public on historical / cultural / archaeological facts, possibly with brochures to take with them. s 7(2)(f)(ii) to continue with this project. - Shell aggregate mixes are being investigated at the OPUS laboratory to establish the best mix for use on the base track. From the Steering Group discussion, it was decided to explore the 'containing' of midden sites with timber edging, thereby differentiating midden shell from track shell. Track edging can also serve this purpose effectively.	- Numbers of visitors for the (financial) year, Base track 868081 and the summit 158764. 3 Rubbish bins have been removed from the base track in a year's trail. So far no complaints have been received and there has been no increase in litter, but we are not in the busy time. - Tauranga City Council, Environment Bay of Plenty and Tauranga Environment Centre have formed a Mauao Care Group. The group meet twice every 5 weeks, once on a weekend and once through the week. - Track up grades. The Track leading up to the Stone Steps is being upgraded. Following this the - Oruahine Track is to be upgraded. Both tracks are in a poor state and need attention. Ice Construction is undertaking the project. They successfully undertook the upgrade of the Waikorire Track last year. - Tests were unsuccessful when trying to make shell pavers for the Base Track. At the last Steering Group Meeting it was deemed that the preferred option was Shell and the second option Rhyllite. - Rock overhang is being assessed for safety measures	s 7(2)(f)(iii)
