- Council will be removing Mexican Alder trees from the La Cumbre Subdivision in consultation with residents. This is a result of a decision made by Council's Monitoring Committee in June 2006. The trees will be replaced with more appropriate tree species. Removal of the trees will occur once the questionnaires sent to affected residents are returned (work is likely to commence in late August). (Arborists)
