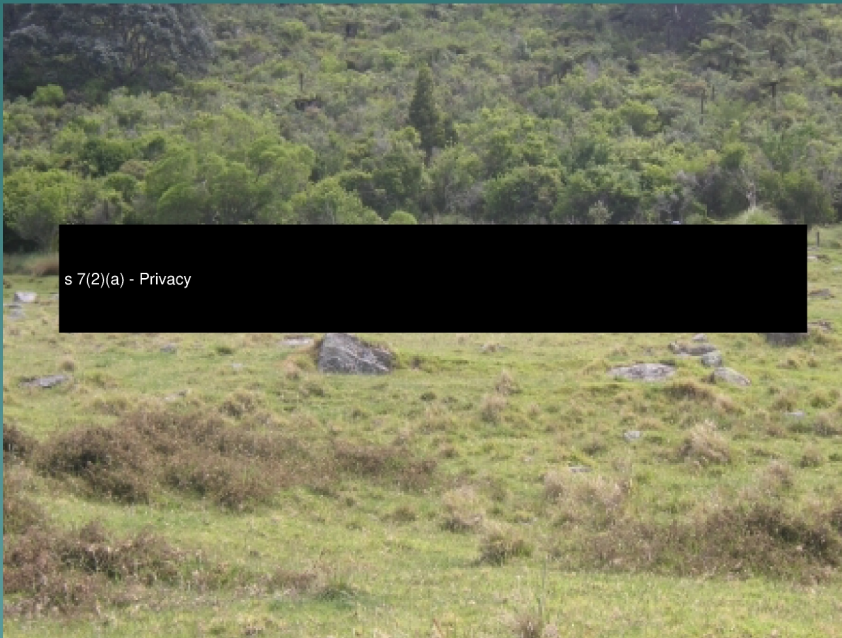

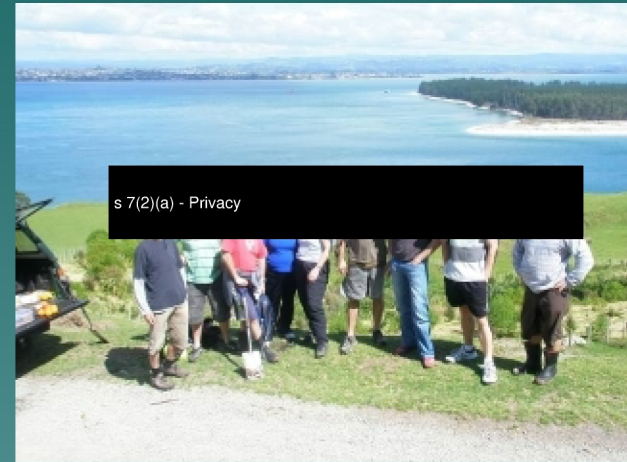

SEATING

Porch rocks and natural timber seating to be provided on the terrace and summit. Porch rocks can be shaped off site, and placed in appropriate places to provide a natural area for people to rest. Carriage from heights where can be incorporated into the rocks to strengthen the landscape concept for Maunao.

Bench seats can be provided using rocks and timber slabs, when pre-fabricated off site. Individually the components of the seats can be moved into place, without disturbance or excavation of the surface, but once they are fixed in place the seats are too heavy to move, unless dismantled.



TRACK SIDE SEATING

Porch rocks and natural seating to be provided in the shade of trees along the edge of tracks, leading to the summit.

Existing track through terraces to be allocated to avoid archaeological sites. New destructive planting to cover existing track areas to avoid reversion to existing track location by pedestrians.



LOOKOUT

The edges of the summit lookout are defined using rocks and low profile planting. The sensitivity of the archaeological sites means that safety fencing can not be installed to the ground. This makes the summit area a significant hazard for pedestrians, given the very steep drops close to the lookout areas.

Rocks can be placed with minimal disturbance to the ground surface, and no ground anchor is required. Localised fencing could be used where no archaeological sites are present.

Materials used for benches on the summit should be consistent with the rest of Maunao.

LEGEND

- Mapped archaeological site boundaries
- Extent of archaeological sites
- Existing pedestrian tracks to be re-installed with vegetation cover to enable protection of archaeological sites
- Existing forest to be augmented with new plantings to cover edges of archaeological sites, look-out areas, and tracks
- Shrub and understory planting
- Rocks and planting to provide edges for look-out areas and trails. Rocks are to be used for bench and seating
- Pedestrian track
- Native grass (understory)
- Assembly grass

Rocks and low profile planting to be provided along the edges of the summit lookout areas.
