General

- Arbor week plantings and 1 hour planting lessons are happening at participating primary schools. This work is being done in conjunction with EBOP and with the support of Arbor Care. (Arborists)
- Reserves plantings will begin in June. (Arborists)
- TCC have been successful in securing Ministry of Youth Development partnership funding of \$75,000 for a joint initiative with Sport BOP and Netball BOP. The funding is for a comprehensive training and support programme for developing secondary school students as coaches and umpires for Netball. s 7(2)(f)(ii)

Mauao

- 7,000 native plants are being planted as infill on re-vegetation areas on Mauao. s 7(2)(f)(ii)
- Night shoots are about to begin after a poison programme on Mauao has been completed for rabbits. s 7(2)(f)(ii)
- The Water pipeline project on Mauao has the go ahead and the site has been blessed. s 7(2)(f)(ii)
- Work on removal/replacement of cladding on the Mount Sports Centre has been slightly delayed. It is now due to occur over the first 2 weeks of June. s 7(2)(f)(ii)

Tauranga

- Whareroa Reserve planting – finished this week. s 7(2)(f)(ii)
- Waiori Stream Planting completed. s 7(2)(f)(ii)
- The new bund at Carlton Reserve is about to be hydra seeded for grass. The reserve will act as a detention pond if there is another major flood occurrence. s 7(2)(f)(ii)
