Ohauti Reserve.

Created new walkways where deep desire lines were present, walkway now goes to the picnic table.



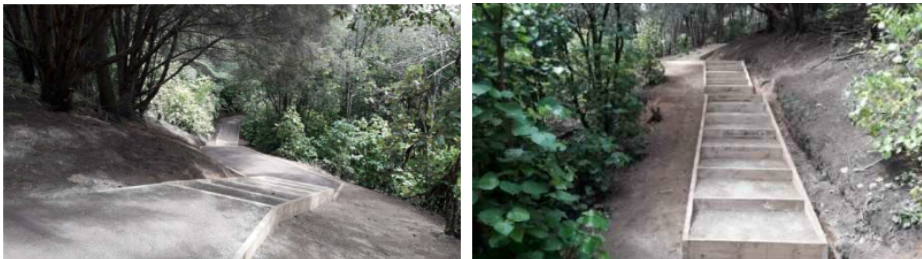
Mclarens Falls.

Renewed Pine tree noel walkway and created an extra track for better access.



Endeavour Heights Reserve.

Renewed the walkway, resulting in a great finish.



Mauao.

Renewed the 4x4 track from the summit down to the bush line. Much safer surface achieved for people using this track.



Improvements made to the steep goat track; stairs added to cut out dangerous sections of the track.



40% through the second stage of the base track resilience project (extending soil nails and netting to secure Pohutukawa).



Multiple nights of rabbit shooting on Mauao resulted in great control (140 shot on Mauao).

Organised this year's planting on Mauao of 10,000 plants, including a trail area for native grass.

Organised the installation of 6 pest monitoring lines over Mauao (due to be installed in the next 3 weeks).

Organised consultation and design of a concept for Waipatukakahu.

Public consultation for the 18th avenue to Fraser reserve project and the Bay street project.
