Subject: MAUAO FIRE FIGHTING WATER LINE

The purpose of this memo is to update you on the progress of this issue.

The contract has been awarded to Fulton Hogan and the current expected completion date is 7th December 2005.

Progress is currently occurring to plan with the installation commenced on the northern face of Mauao.

During the course of awarding the contract, we were approached by the Port of Tauranga who asked if we could put a plastic pipe in the trench between their beacon on the upper northern slope of Mauao and the camp. This is so that in future they can replace their existing power supply (which is only in a shallow trench at present) without any excavation in the future.

This was agreed as a practical solution and was agreed by the on-site monitoring representatives.

It has become apparent that this decision may require either a new resource consent, a variation to the existing consent, or no consent at all.

Once we have established this, and if a consent or variation to the consent is needed, we will ensure this is applied for prior to any use of this extra pipe for power supply to the Port Beacon.
