

Following our meeting held 6 December 1999 to discuss the actions required by Council in response to hazards identified in the above report, I have spoken with the Director of City Services and can advise as follows:

Those sites which require geotechnical stabilisation to eliminate hazard to campers should be closed. As per the report, those sites which require immediate action should be closed ie bookings cancelled. For those sites indicated as less urgent, please advise the Camp contractors to cease taking bookings. Sites as follow and indicated on attached plan:

- Ocean Camp : 111,112, 90, 89, 87, 25
- Harbour Camp 87, 86, 85, 92

In addition, to implement the “**Mauao Management Plan**” (1998) in regard to accessing Mauao through camp ground (3.3.3), please advise the contractors to cease accepting bookings for the Ocean Camp sites 1 – 64.

I refer you to **Operational Service Contract**, Mt Maunganui Domain Camp CS29/99, Clause 7.4 of the Project Specification which I attach for your information. This clause refers to a number of issues which may impact on the future management of the camp and identifies that camp sites may be lost to improve Reserve access and because of geotechnical implications.
