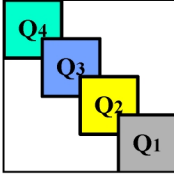

On 30 August 1999 I wrote to you enclosing a letter from Sharp Tudhope concerning the Council's responsibilities and liabilities in respect of the danger that possible instability on Mauao poses to people on and around the mountain. I listed the concerns that fell within the ambit of the activities of the Facilities/Reserves Division and requested your advice.

A month later on 30 September I provided you with a copy of a report due to go to Council and I requested a reply to my memo of 30 August.

On 1 October I copied you with a memo that I sent to the [Redacted] In that memo I referred to the two earlier memos which I copied to him.

I am concerned that I still do not have a response from you on these matters.

I now enclose a copy of a report from Shrimpton and Lipinski that I received last Friday night. The report details work to be done at the Motor Camp and on Mauao to protect the public from possible hazards.

Being reserve land I am hesitant to initiate anything without the full knowledge and support of your Division. For this reason I have copied the report to [Redacted] and have asked that she join [Redacted] [Redacted] and myself in inspecting the affected land.
